CMP Excellence in Completion (EIC) Match will start 8:00 AM.

**Rules:** Current CMP Competition rulebook will govern.

**Firearms:** CMP approved.

**Entries:** Entry Fee: \$30.00 / EIC match. . Pre-registration is encouraged & can be made via email or phone. Preference given to non-distinguished first! Entries close 7:40am day of match. (60 entries available, lets fill it up!).

**CMP Affidavit:** A notarized "Eligibility Affidavit & Liability Agreement", as required by the CMP must be on file at this range prior to firing this match. No notary public will be at the range. The wrist ribbon you get at Nationals check in means you are on file already. If you require an Eligibility form, you may download it from the CMP :<http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/Affidavit.pdf>

**Squadding:** With on-site registration at the club house 7:00 to 7:40 am, pits seal at 7:55 am Entries close 7:40 am day of match. Squadding will remain for the entire match. There will be no lunch provided and no lunch breaks.

**Firing Starts:** CMP Excellence in Competition (EIC) Rifle Match starts at 8:00 AM.

**Course of Fire:** No sighting shots per CMP rules! See Rule 8.4 & Table 7.

A 3 minute preparation period precedes all firing stages below:

200 yds, SR target, 10 shots slow fire, standing. Time Limit - 10 minutes.

200 yds, SR target, 10 shots rapid fire, from standing to sitting or kneeling. Time Limit - 60 seconds.

300 yds, SR-3 target, 10 shots rapid fire, from standing to prone. Time Limit - 70 seconds.

600 yds, MR-1 target, 20 shots slow fire, prone. Time Limit - 20 minutes.

**Ammunition:** Competitors must supply their own safe ammunition. No incendiary, tracer, or armor piecing ammo.

**Match Director's Safety Requirements:**

- Side arms will not be permitted on the shooter's person while in position and participating in the match. They may be kept in the shooter's gear bag, range cart, or in an automobile.
- At no time, will any non-competitor, other than paid pit pullers, enter the pits during live fire. This includes spouses, significant others, and children. Children over the age of 12 may attend and participate in the match if properly supervised by a legal parent or guardian, however due to safety concerns, unattended children who are not

properly supervised, who are not participating in the event will not be permitted on the range for the duration of the event. No exceptions!

- Any unsafe activity of any participant may result in forfeiture of record score, paid match fees, and the competitor will be asked to exit the range. No exceptions!
- 3-shot rule: If any competitor is not on paper at the 600 yard stage of the match after firing 3 shots, consisting of both sighting and record shots, that competitor will not be permitted to continue that stage of the match. This rule is strictly adhered to for reasons of safety and the increased possibility of skipping a bullet out of the range. If you are not sure of your zero, ask the match director to help you before you fire your 1st shot.
- Eye and hearing protection is required in the pits and while on the firing line.

**Awards:** EIC "LEG" points and placement medals will be determined by and issued by the CMP.
